Cancellation of enrolment after Week 1 of any term is non-refundable if a student withdraws from classes. Refunds will be made only if The Jazz Factory cancels a class.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR 2021

Please note the following rules apply :-

- Jazz, Hip Hop, Ballet, Tap and JF Theatre Company are the only genres you can enrol in, for one class a week.
- Contemporary, Lyrical, Musical Theatre, Technique and Acro are second weekly classes and MUST be taken with a Jazz class.
- Exam Classes and senior stream classes must take a second weekly jazz class AND technique and/or ballet. Both ballet and technique are recommended.
- Students invited to 2021 exam classes and Pre-senior jazz students will receive an invitation by email in November.
- 2020 Exam students will be able to discuss 2021 classes once they have received their exam marks.
- Year 12 senior stream students in 2021 may take contemporary and/or lyrical instead of a second weekly jazz class with technique and/or ballet (please discuss with Kim).

* Intermediate and Advanced Acro are skills based

Students who are unsure what level of Acro they are can be assessed during the first week of classes

Intermediate Acro Skills – Forward and Back walkovers (or very close to it)

Good strength, flexibility and placement in technique

Advanced Acro Skills - Close to perfect technique in all intermediate level skills

Side Aerial, Back Handspring and Front Aerial (or close to it)

High level of strength and flexibility and very driven mindset

What is The Jazz Factory Theatre Company?

The Jazz Factory Theatre Company is a chance for passionate singers, dancers and actors, to work on their skills while putting on a professional musical theatre production.

The theatre company is open to all students (including non-JF students) and rehearses on a Saturday from 2:30-5:30 for a Semester. We have two theatre companies currently – a Junior Theatre Company for ages 8-12 and a Senior Theatre Company for ages 13-18.

In 2021, we will be combining our two companies to perform the fabulously entertaining and exciting musical - Shrek Jr at the Zenith Theatre on June 19th and 20th.

While Theatre Company students do not need to be enrolled in weekly classes, we encourage students to take tap and jazz to help with Shrek choreography. Students wishing to build their musical theatre skills and audition technique further, should enrol in our musical theatre classes on a Thursday.

Depending on enrolment numbers, we may split the show into a junior and senior cast. We will advise accordingly next year. Students do not have to audition to be a part of our theatre company, everyone who enrolls gets a part!

Theatre Company is a one semester commitment.

What is the JF Dance Company?

The JF Dance Company is for elite dancers in year 5+ with strong technique, style and performance quality. Students will have a variety of performance opportunities throughout the year including eisteddfods and community events. While we do enter some eisteddfods, the focus of the dance company is in training dancers to work as professionals rather than in a pure competitive environment.

Students can audition in the styles of Contemporary and Hip Hop during the final week of term. Students will be required to show their strength and flexibility, technique, style, ability to pick up choreography and performance quality.

Students successful in gaining a place in our Dance Company are committing themselves to Friday rehearsals from 4-7pm (times to be confirmed each term). Soloists may be scheduled at other times throughout the week depending on availability.

After auditions, the Company will be cast accordingly, into either troupes/crews, duos/trios and/or soloists.

Soloists will be responsible for entering their own competitions and organising their own costumes. Other company members will be charged up to \$150 for costumes.

There is also a commitment to weekend performances that run between May and November, in line with public school terms.

Dance company troupes/crews are included in the 6+ and 9+ classes cap. Solos/Duos/Trios are charged as private lessons.

Students need to be enrolled in jazz and contemporary and/or hip hop by Monday 7th December in order to audition for the dance company.
