We hope you are getting excited to see your little dancer performing at our Pre School Concerts on Sunday November 28th!

We have two pre school concerts again this year -

3:00pm concert 1 - Ready Set Dance Monday and Ready Set Dance and Ready Set Ballet Friday classes.

4:30pm concert 2 - All Ready Set Dance and Ready Set Ballet Saturday classes

Both concerts are at the **Zenith Theatre** - Cnr McIntosh Street and Railway Street, Chatswood.

Students in Concert 1 should arrive at 2:30pm

Students in Concert 2 should arrive at 4:00pm

Students and Parents will need to sign in on arrival and students will be taken through the theatre to find their place side stage with their class.

Please note that all audience members must be fully vaccinated or have a valid medical exemption. Everyone 12 and over must wear a mask in the theatre.

This can be worn with anything PINK AND/OR BLACK - Shorts, Pants, Tutus, Skirts, Leggings with Jazz or Ballet Shoes (black socks or stocking socks). Boys can wear their JF basketball shorts if they want, with either jazz shoes or sneakers (black socks).

Hair can be in any creative, funky style, off the face, with any black and/or pink accessories - Braids, Pigtails, Ribbons, Scrunchies, Caps. Be as creative as you like :)

Audience lights are left on so your child will be able to see you clearly sitting in the audience.
